



Analysis of Parents' Questionnaire March 2015

37 out of a possible 115 questionnaires returned which represents a 32% response.

Summary:

- The majority of the respondents either agreed or strongly agreed with the statements (responses ranging from 81% -100%)
- A small minority of the respondents disagreed /strongly disagreed with the statements (responses ranged from 0% -12%)
- A minority of respondents answered "don't know" to some of the statements (0%-16%) this was noticeable for how the school deals effectively with bullying. It may also be attributed to the fact that they have no experience of their son/daughter being bullied.

There were 3 suggestions made on the completed questionnaires:

- Reminders for overdue payments to be sent by text rather than by post to save money.
- Information on accreditation being used for farm or land based studies for clarification.
- Greater advance notice for plays and performances taking place.

Areas in which parents have responded most positively:

- My son / daughter feels happy and safe, they are well looked after.
- The academy is well led and managed.
- The academy responds effectively to concerns raised by parents and keeps them informed of pupil's progress.
- Behaviour is good
- Pupils are taught well and make good progress
- Most parents would recommend the academy to other parents

Areas in which a small minority of parents responded less positively:

- That their son / daughter did not receive appropriate homework for their age and ability
- That they did not receive information from the school about their son / daughter's progress

The results speak for themselves and demonstrate massive strides forward in parent satisfaction. There were many very positive quotes from parents and carers indicating that their child is very happy and making excellent progress.
