Young People and Vulnerable Adults

Young people and vulnerable adults can be subjected to:

Physical abuse

Sexual abuse

Financial abuse

Bullying

Emotional abuse

Neglect

We ask you to safeguard our young people and vulnerable adults by:

Signing in and out at the main reception

Visibly wearing your visitors pass

Remaining in the area you have permission to access

Being mindful of your own behaviours in relation to our learners

Acting promptly if you observe or are approached by a learner in distress

All electronic devices including mobile phones are switched off

If you have concerns:

Do not promise confidentiality

Contact the safeguarding team

Tell the learner what you are doing and why

Do not investigate

Do make a record of the conversation
