Qualifications students gain will depend on how many years they participate in horticulture. In some years students may receive unit certification as there are not enough units to ensure an award for every year of study. Any student working towards this course will gain an Entry 3 award (KS4) and a Level 1 award (KS5). If KS4 students do a second year (either in Y11 or Y12) they would then receive a level 1 award. Any student opting in KS4 in 2016/17 for the first time would only be able to get unit certification unless they choose to carry it on in Post 16. If a student participates in gardening for three years they will be able to gain a Level 1 Certificate. All gardening skills will be covered throughout every year, but the focus of the written work will be the unit on the curriculum map. Evidence of all gardening skills will be gathered throughout the year and this will be drawn on and used in when focussing on assignment units.
