Issues

1. Matt Tonks issues: would like to be able to have Salad as the veg option with the main meal and put down as a coloured option on the order sheet.
2. Passwords need to be installed on laptops as students are having their work defaced or deleted.
3. Can sports day have a contingency date in case of bad weather as students really want to have sports day every year?
4. James Thomas: asks can the basketball hoop be put back in the cage so KS4 have something else to do at break times?
5. Jordan also discussed that the ultimate burger on the dinner menu isn't suitable for students and therefore asked councillors to discuss in classes if they should ask if it can be removed.
6. Jordan also discussed the possibility of vending machines in the Old Hall as appropriate for college students.
7. Matt Kirkham also talked about urgent need for cleaner cutlery at dinnertimes. Everyone in the council agreed with the idea for new

dessert spoons to replace the table spoons which are unsuitable for eating.

8. Matt also asked for new blinds for the classrooms in the old hall as the current blinds are broken
9. Matt also asked for the laptops to be repaired as soon as possible
10. We also asked for the toilets to be upgraded in the boys toilets which are smelly and horrible.
11. We talked about having salt and pepper and ketchup twice a week for students (in sachets to limit overuse)
12. We talked about a common room for P16 students to use at break times.
13. We also we talked about door wedges for the doors in post 16 to make it easier for people to get around freely as they are extremely heavy to use.
14. Behaviour reward system for students that have been well behaved during the week / vouchers for student best behaved for a term. It feels like all the attention and rewards go to the badly behaved students.
15. Can we have more permanent plastic cups for students to drink out from as we are running out of cups to use.
16. Jordan Bailey suggested the use of social network for students in Old Hall but the council realised it wouldn't be allowed to happen as it is against school rules.
